**Speaking requirements**

The time limit for a presentation is up to 10 minutes.

An electronic collection of abstracts will be published at the end of the roundtable. It will be available to the public in the BSUFL repository.

**Procedure for submitting materials**

Abstracts of the report are due to be sent to the Organizing Committee's e-mail address [eastlang@bsufl.by](mailto:eastlang@bsufl.by) by **December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025**. The subject line of the e-mail message should include the word *roundtable*. Materials should be sent as a file attachment to the e-mail. File name format – *Surname initials.doc* or *Surname initials.docx* depending on the version of your text editor.

**Terms of publishing**

By submitting your materials, you are confirming that the work is original and has not been previously published. All co-authors have agreed to the publication of the abstracts and have given permission for the processing of personal data. The abstracts will

be published in the author's version. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to select which materials will be accepted for publication.

### **Requirements to the materials design**

The volume of your abstracts should not exceed 3 A4 pages. Please, use Times New Roman font size 14 points, single line spacing, and a paragraph indent of 1.25 centimeters. All margins should be 2 centimeters. The text should be aligned to the width of the page. Pages should not be numbered.

The title should be centred on the first line in bold without hyphenation. After a space, the last name and initials of the author should be listed. Then, the name of the educational institution and country should be included.

After another space, the text of the paper should begin. References to sources should be given in square brackets, such as [3, p. 23].

A list of references should be provided at the end of the abstracts. The list can be organized by citation order or alphabetically in accordance with the requirements of the Higher Attestation Commission of the Republic of Belarus (<https://vak.gov.by/node/8026>).
